## **CEO'S CORNER**

The year is progressing quickly, and the team at Big Chill are doing really well to navigate the usual winter weather and road disruptions. Indeed, now we are past the Kaikoura earthquake disruptions, this is our first normal year for some time. It is a welcome change for both staff and customers.

Our focus is turning now to Christmas/Summer planning, and ensuring our teams have the resources in place to manage the anticipated volumes. This includes sitting down with key large volume 3PL & Transport customers, and planning their specific needs.

Big Chill continues its drive around investing in its depot and network infrastructure. We currently have no less than 3 depot projects under way, with expansions in Auckland (scheduled completion Feb 2020), Hastings (completion early 2020) and Wellington (completion June 2020) underway.

Once completed these facility enhancements will allow us to further meet customer growth demand in 3PL and transport services. In addition we continue to look at other building opportunities into 2021/22. The global business environment maybe entering a pessimistic phase, but we are not!!

From a vehicle investment perspective we recently committed to Volvo NZ in ordering 18 new tractors & 4 new 8x4 rigids. These will arrive across the rest of 2019 and into early next year, and largely replace existing units. It's an important move in terms of maintaining a young and fuel efficient fleet. Importantly, Big Chill is also exploring the feasibility of deploying its first fully electric trucks. Working in conjunction with TR Group and EECA, we would hope to be able to place an order for two trucks late in 2019, with deployment in the first half of next year.

Finally, I wish to say farewell to Mark Rea, our General Manager – Business Development, who has been with Big Chill for 20 years this year. Mark leaves Big Chill at the end of August to relocate to Australia to enjoy more time with family. We wish him all the very best, and we know he will continue to look across the Tasman at how Big Chill continues to develop and grow. He is a hugely respected member of the Big Chill Board and business as a whole, and he will be missed. Personally, I would like to extend my thanks to Mark for his

unwavering support, honest opinions (wanted or not) and hard work across my time as CEO. It has been a privilege to work with you, and I've learned much from you. Safe Travels.


