Big Chill Nation-Wide



Auckland

The extension to the Auckland site is well underway and the progress is looking amazing. The new facility will be able to house 9,500 pallets of frozen and / or chilled products for our customers. There will be two rooms that form part of the extension each of equal size.



As there has been limited temperature controlled 3PL storage capacity developed in the past 10 years. It will be exciting to have the new facility operational in late March 2020 to offer our customers an ability to grow their businesses. With a well-established Warehouse Management System, the 3PL and Transport solutions that Big Chill provide our customers, will be integrated.





Hastings

We are pleased to announce that we are extending the Hastings depot by one additional dock, an expansion of the ELA loading and unloading area. The extension maximizes the capacity we have on the site and allows the team to cater for our growing volumes. The extension will be completed by June 2020.

Wellington

With extensive growth in the Wellington region we have embarked on a significant extension of the depot. Currently our depot operates 4 docks with a freezer and chiller for cross docking freight. The extension will double the size of the operation to a 9 dock facility and larger freezers and chillers to cater for the large volumes. The build is underway with an expected completion date of June 2020.
